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ORDER:

The Collector of Dharmapuri District has sent a proposal to address the problem of Naxalism in Dharmapuri District through certain activities of socio economic development. The Government have examined the proposal in detail in consultation with the State Planning Commission and the Departments concerned.

2. The proposal along with the views of the State Planning Commission have been discussed by the Development Commissioner / Secretary to Government. Finance Department with the Secretaries / Head of Departments concerned and decided to accord sanction to the following initiatives / activities at the cost mentioned against each of them.

9.	Provision of Additional street lights by TEDA (State share)	10.03
10.	Construction of HSC Buildings and Doctors Quarters (PHCs) – to be taken up at the remote and inaccessible places in consultation with DPH & PM.	60.57
11.	Recruitment of Community Health Volunteer (100 Nos. for 3 months – Local Volunteers at Rs.1000/-)	3.00

3. The Government after careful consideration have decided to accept the decisions referred to in para-2 above and accordingly, sanction the release of Rs.5,00,00,000/- (Rupees five crores only) to Dharmapuri District, to implement the initiatives / activities mentioned above.
4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account.

“2515-Other Rural Development Programme – 102-Community Development – Schemes in the Xth Five Year Plan – II State Plan-KI. Programme for comprehensive Development in Dharmapuri District – 09. Grants in aid -03-Grants for Specific Schemes (DPC 2515-00-102-KI-0931).

5. The Collector of Dharmapuri District is authorised to draw and place the amount at the disposal of Dharmapuri District Economic Development Society formed for the purpose. The amount shall be utilised for specific schemes shall be monitored by Dharmapuri District Economic Development Society and Rural Development Department. The Collector shall furnish the utilisation Certificates in the prescribed format at appropriate stages to the Director of Rural Development for record. He shall also send a periodical progress report on utilisation of funds and achievements thereon to the Director of Rural Development. PD&SI Department, Finance Department, and the Rural Development Department.
6. The Director of Rural Development shall monitor the progress of the scheme (and also maintain the registers on creation of assets etc., as indicated in TNFC Volume 1.)
7. The decisions of Government on other initiatives and suggestions of Collector, Dharmapuri District will be issued separately.
